**Camp Olowalu is not an approved quarantine location.** All reservations will be done by calling our reservations office or you may also book online at [campolowalu.com](http://campolowalu.com). Office hours are from 8:30am-4:30pm, 7 days a week.

There are additional expectations regarding sanitation and safety. Please follow all federal, state and local guidelines. Please see below for additional rules and guidelines that must be followed at this time.

- No gatherings greater than 10 people
- Must present valid ID and COVID-19 required documentation upon check in for every guest
- Check in must be done by 4pm to gain entry
- No day use guest
- No linens for tentalsows, or rental gear will be available.
- A key will be given for the assigned bathrooms and showers.
- Should the key be lost there will be a key replacement fee
- It will be required to wear a mask upon check in and when going to and from reservation location and common areas, restrooms and showers.

Please be mindful and practice safe distancing rules and guidelines of 6ft from other campers/employees in the area and on the beach.

Office and Camp Store will be open during normal operating times. However, we will service you through a service window.

Our office during this time will remain cashless. All transactions will require payment via credit card.
